School Photos – Monday 12th **August**

We have a different photographer this year and so the process is slightly different to what we have done in the past.

- If you wish to have family/sibling photos taken you will need to fill in a form and return it to school prior to photo day. We have copied a sample with this newsletter, but please ask at the office for the correct sibling form. Complete and return to office asap.
- A couple of weeks after photos are taken we will receive a Photo Shoot Keycode for each child and these will be sent home to you along manual ordering envelopes.
- However, with the keycodes you will be able to go online and order direct from them. This should be a much easier option for many.
- We will send home more information the week before photos are taken.

FAQs about PhotoLife's Online Ordering System

- When will my child's photos be ready to view Online?
 As soon as you receive your Photo Shoot Keycode you can go online and view your child's photographs. Class Group, Portraits, Sports Teams and Cultural Groups (if photographed) will be added into the Photo Shoot Keycode over the school year.
- 2. Can anyone else see my child's photo Online?
 In order to view your child's photos you have to have the unique Photo Shoot Keycode. Without this code no one else can see your child's photos.
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 3. How can I make sure I get the FREE DELIVENY offer?

 PhotoLife gives a "free deliveny" period of approximately 3 weeks from the date the Photo Shoot Keys are dispatched to the School. It is best to go online straight away and place your order.

 The Expiry Date of the "free delivery" period for your child's school is clearly shown on the website and automatically expires when that date is reached.
- What happens once the "free delivery" period expires?

 All of the orders placed before the expiry will be bulk printed and then dispatched to the school for your child to biring home.

 If you missed getting your order in before the expiry date then your order will be dispatched to the address typed in by the person placing the order. A 56.00 Postage & Packing charge is automatically applied.

Sibling Photographs


If your school has approved for us to take Sibling Photographs you need to do the
