Community Testing Centres

Northland DHB is establishing COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Community Testing Centres throughout Northland, with the first centres opening in Whangarei, Kaitaia, Kerikeri, Kaikohe and Kawakawa this Friday, 20 March.

“The purpose of a Community Testing Centre is to test people who have symptoms of COVID-19 and who have travelled overseas in the last two weeks or think they have been exposed to COVID-19.

“The centres are for testing only and will not be providing medical care or assessment. If you are feeling unwell and are sick enough to normally see your doctor please call your GP for an appointment.”

Healthline remains the first point of contact for people who are unwell and have symptoms of COVID-19. Healthline will provide guidance on whether testing is needed and will indicate whether people should contact their GP for a referral to a testing centre.
