



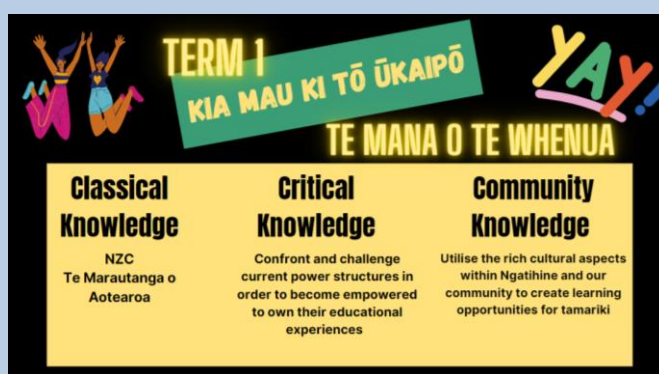

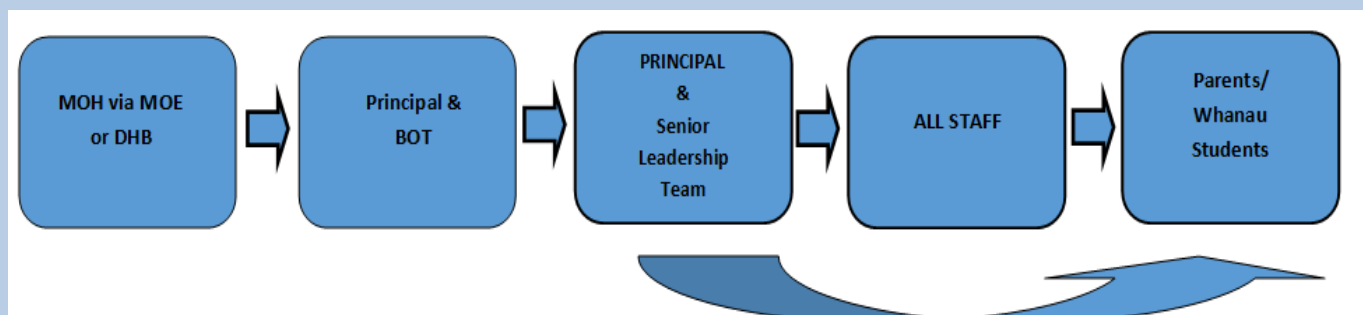

KEEPING AHEAD OF COVID-19-19

What Whānau Need to Know

In order to keep our school community functioning safely we are asking our whānau to be vigilant, and communicate with us if your tamariki are unwell OR if your household is impacted by COVID-19 (see attached COVID-19 flow chart). Moerewa School will follow the instruction of MOH/MOE when there is a case in the school and we will communicate accordingly.



Students

Teachers will do a visual check of tamariki each morning during karakia. If flu-like symptoms are identified, whānau will be contacted to pick up students immediately and a request is made to have them tested and monitor symptoms. We kindly ask that siblings go home also. If one child is away from school due to illness, all siblings must also remain at home for the duration and a request is made to have them tested prior to returning.

Contacts Update

We are already having issues contacting whanau when children are sick. It is imperative that there is someone we can contact at all times. Please complete the attached 'Contact Update' form and return immediately to the school office. We need at least 2 phone numbers that are able to be answered all day. Please add other emergency contacts if necessary. Thank you for understanding the importance of this.

Staff

If COVID-19 symptoms are displayed by staff, they must return a negative test before returning to school. If they have COVID-19 or a household member has COVID-19, they must isolate as instructed by MOH.

If multiple teachers are away due to COVID-19: Tamariki will be placed in with the other bubble teacher if numbers permit OR a reliever will be employed. Should there be a large number of staff away in a Whanau Bubble or relievers cannot be sourced, then MOE will be informed. This will mean that Parents will be advised via Facebook and text notification, the night prior, that there will be no school for that bubble that day. Online learning/learning hard packs will be made available.

If multiple Pouwhirinaki are away due to COVID-19 – especially those who work with our most vulnerable (ORS/SENCO) students: If we are unable to provide alternative, adequate, safe supervision for tamariki, we will let whanau know via a phone call.

All Visitors To The School

We are being extra vigilant with visitors to our school. It is important that ALL whanau use the tracing app and sanitising station located at the office door, before signing in. If anyone is dropping off lunches or collecting students please remain at reception to be assisted.
